Mind the Gap

Provide academic and practical tools to support Tel Aviv University law students impacted by the war, including peer mentorship, small group tutorials, development of accessible materials, career plan re-adjustment and supporting students who were drafted for reserve duty, evacuated from their homes in the south or the north of the country, and other adversely impacted students, such as those whose close relatives were murdered, wounded, captive or missing.

EVACUEES

Alon & Ella “Iron Swords” Emergency Aid

Alon and Ella is now operating 5 operation rooms to respond immediately to evacuated residents, who are staying in shelters, families of the injured victims in 7 hospitals across Israel and IDF soldiers on the front line and staging areas. With over 6000 active volunteers who are ready to respond and process any need from the field.

Support children and their families that have been struck during the war and evacuated from their homes on the conflict line, with the goal of providing them with some respite in national parks and nature reserves in the areas to which they have been evacuated.

ADI Negev Rehab Village

Should the entire Hospital need to enter protected spaces all at once and for a prolonged period of time, the hospital will need to use all of its underground space, which is not up to the highest safety standards at this moment.

SECURITY

City of Ashdod Security Corp and Units

The Kiriyat Gat Foundation

The cost of renovating a single shelter ranges between a few hundred Shekels and 7,000 Shekels. There are many dozens of shelters across the city in need of renovation.

Organic Israel is a volunteer non-profit consisting of experienced farmers and agri-tech specialists. Our main goal right now is to support the Gaza Envelope agricultural communities - organic and non-organic - which were dealt a severe blow during the current war. Since this geographical area is a critical agricultural region of the country (known as Israel's Barn), it is imperative to work rapidly to restore these farmlands and guard our national food security. After mapping the needs of these farms, we are ready to provide immediate First Aid, such as repair and purchase of critical agricultural infrastructure, replacement of stolen equipment, technical and professional support, etc. We are sure that our assistance has a vital impact on these farms, which strive to return - even under constant fire - to being productive again.

Legacy Forward-

In memoriam of the Kedem-Siman Tov family z"l

The initiative aims to preserve the enduring legacy of this remarkable family and provide support to the survivors of the Nir-Oz community through a one-on-one, long-term mentoring program for affected families and assistance for emerging leaders within the Nir-Oz community. While the majority of the work will be carried out by dedicated volunteers, funding will be required in two months for a part-time project manager, necessary professionals, and operational costs.

Additionally, community events and activities will be organized, and funding will be necessary to address any future needs of the community that may arise.

Social Finance Israel

As the war in Israel continues, many businesses in the south are closed and continue to be affected by the ongoing conflict. While the government will distribute grants and aid funds, the process can take several months. We are launching a zero-interest bridge loan fund that will get funds to businesses fast and will be repaid as soon as government funds are received.

Building Resilience in Bedouin Unincorporated Villages in the Negev

During the horrific events of October 7th, dozens of Bedouins were killed or taken hostage to Gaza. The resilience centers in southern Israel are not equipped to work with the unincorporated villages. Therefore basic therapeutic and emotional care (“first aid”) training is needed for the education, welfare, and healthcare professionals in these villages in order to treat the ongoing trauma and work to minimize post-trauma.
